It's the 6th of May 2026. It's a Wednesday. The time is 2.47 p.m. I am going to try Abu whatsapp. Oh, Mr. Abu, can you speak for a minute now?

Yes, sure.

[Speaker 1] (0:39 - 1:20)

So I had told you I would send you 400 a month. So I had sent the last one on April 7th and I'm doing some stuff now. But tomorrow I will be sending you another 400.

Yes. Regarding the case that you are saying that you are not giving us any information because, you know, Alex and I are very different. Alex just leaves it up to you.

But I feel you should be giving us the earlier will, which you said you didn't do. Which one? You know, the earlier will.

You said there's an earlier will, but you didn't.

Okay, okay, right. I asked my assistant. Okay, we'll get it today.

All the information I will email you today. If you want, I can forward it to Alex as well. Okay?

Oh, Mr. Abu, you have sent with you a correspondence to reply within 15 days and she has failed to do so. Is that right?

Now we are preparing to file a case.

So Mr. Abu, I think you have a strong grounds to get the 15,000 back as well as the remainder. Because of our non-compliance, you had to go to court again. So there's an additional charge.

Now, what I want, I will not contact her. I will never contact her. You need to send me...

I will not contact her. No, no. I'm telling you that you've got to trust me.

I will not contact with you and Alex will not. So you have to trust me about that and whatever correspondence you send her, I need to know you are sending it to her. So you need to send me a copy, like last time when you sent me to her.

Of course.

We are in a bundle of documents, right? Once it is done, probably it will take a week, right? Once it is done, before sending to her, I will send it to you.

Okay? Mr. Abu, the thing is that when she writes you any responses from her or her lawyer, you need to send it to me. Because, I mean, you may be the expert, but there may be something I need to tell you, which is if you don't want...

I'll give it to you. No problem. No problem.

I'll give it to you. Now, the other thing is that although you may be able to recover the court costs from her for noncompliance, I'm wondering if you do not have a case when there is no other information. So, I mean, you can say I'm the influence, but for example, there are two times when she...

I mean, she was pretending that my father was living in Carson Grove, when in fact he had moved to her house or the nursing home, and somebody made a fake signature as my father, so I would... We'll talk about it.

We'll talk about it later. We haven't got to that stage yet, right? When we prepared this case, I spoke to you many times about it, right?

So, there will be a situation. We'll talk about it. I will have a full conference with you.

Now, the point is whether you accept that you don't have any case at all. Is that what you accept?

No, no. I don't believe in fraud or something. You don't have evidence to plead fraud.

So, I want to analyse the document. Now, what I've done is... Now, what I've done is I know you need an expert.

It'll cost a lot of money, but here's the deal. The document... I do some very simple things, and there's a guy who works here, and he's Pakistani.

He's a graduate in document examination, but he has not yet got a licence because he's very young. He said he would take a look at it, but he's not going to give a written report. He's not a licenced expert.

But before that happens, I want to... No, I want to... No, we must do it now, because if there is a fraud in the digital document...

The letter of wishes and the will, they are a PDF document. If fraud is suspected, we can take it to a higher level. But there's another issue here.

There's another... Yeah. Okay.

Let me explain to you. I told you the time will come. If it is needed, we'll hire an expert to check the document.

Is it fake or not? So the situation will come, okay? We are not at that stage yet.

No, Mr. Abu, here's what I'm telling you. At some stage, you will ask her to send the original or a notary copy of the original. Yes, of course.

Of course, that is a good procedure. Without seeing the original, the case won't go ahead.

But Mr. Abu, here's the deal. Here's the deal. Having the original, it will be a paper document.

Verifying that with an expert, whether there's any fraud in it, is a very costly process because they have to use something like an electron microscope. But analysing the digital document is relatively cheaper, even if you use an expert. And so I was thinking that there is some suspicion in this document through a preliminary run.

And I...

You know, when we file this case, after filing this case, then you have ample opportunity to do that. If right now, if you want to do anything in your case... I'm not saying anything.

I'm only talking to you about things, because things take time. So that's why I'm talking from my side, okay? I'm trying to minimise costs.

It is noted. It is noted, yes. So what I'm saying now is that I want to analyse the digital copy for fraud.

And that graduate young man hasn't got back to me, but Chatjee says that there is some suspicion. So why don't you get a higher-resolution document? Because he has wiped out all the metadata and made it so that I cannot have any information on the, you know.

So I want to ask you, if it is possible, to ask her for a higher-resolution scan where she doesn't remove metadata. I'll give you the instructions Chatjee gave me, but she may not do it. The other one is...

You don't have the licence, right?

[Speaker 1] (7:22 - 7:37)

No, it's not the guy. Chatjee is the guy. Chatjee is not a lawyer.

No, we are not going to court. We are doing low-level science. We are not going to court yet.

If I find anything suspicious, then I take it to a higher level, to a lawyer or an expert. Fine.

No problem. No problem. That's why I say, whatever you want to do, you do it.

No problem.

[Speaker 1] (7:42 - 8:24)

So one thing I wanted to ask you, to ask for your help to do this, to carry this out on a lower level, will we be able to get a higher-resolution scan of the will? Can we get one that she actually does on a flatbed scanner, or have somebody you trust to do the scan for you? That is one thing that Chatjee asked, because she's not done a very good scan.

The second one is whether you can reply for the passport of my mother and father, at least an authorised copy. So if she goes to a notary, and she shows the passport, and they scan it, there won't be any fraud. And that way, I have a sample of that signature.

Okay, we will ask them to disclose your father's passport copyright.

The passport of the mother, can she give an authorised copy?

Okay, then fine.

The other thing is, can she have these wills scanned by a person who you trust, not who she trusts? And that way, I can do the lower-level examination, even take it to an expert, because the money the expert will charge for analysing a digital document is less than the paper document. That is very expensive.

So if she gives us a proper digital document, if there's someone you trust, or a notary, because when I did my notary scans and other scans, I use a scanner. I mean, the notary themselves do the photocopying. The notaries do the photocopying.

Whatever I'm saying, whatever you're doing, you keep doing it, make a note of it, keep it with you. So I will let you know when the time comes. Your case is not ready, so now I understand you want to plead fraud.

If there is fraud, if there is fraud, it's not going to be the same. My saying it is not going to come.

If you want to plead, if you want to say the case like there is a fraud, you can plead, no problem.

If you think it's a fraud, what do you do? I want to verify. I want to verify if there is a fraud.

So you can verify it. But I need the digital examination, not the paper one, because the paper one is very, very expensive. So how do you do that?

So one thing is whether it's possible for Vigil to take the bill and lend it to someone you trust who will do the scan. If it's a notary, even notaries, they do their own scans. Then the scan, I don't want the paper, I want the scan.

And is it possible to request my parents' passports, my mother and father's passports?

Why should I have a problem?
