Conditions

1. You must not contact directly or indirectly or via their places of work and education Viju Wortley, her partner or her children.
2. You must not enter Hampshire except to attend court or a pre-arranged appointments with her Solicitor.
3. You must live and sleep each night at 26 Bourne Court, South Ruislip, Middlesex, HA4 6SW.

This is:

1. To make sure that you go to court for the next hearing.
2. To stop you interfering with witnesses or the course of justice in your own or anybody else's case.
3. To stop you committing offences while you are on bail.

Warning

If you do not keep any of these conditions you can be **arrested** and brought back to court. Unless your attendance has been excused at the next hearing and recorded above, you will commit an **offence** if you do not attend court on the date and at the time and place shown. If you do not attend when told a warrant may be issued for your arrest.

Note

You should attend Court **30** minutes before the time shown above and have seen your Solicitor (if you have one), in good time before the date of hearing.
