

URGENT/IMMEDIATE QUEST

But my urgent quest is to find out if the caveat number I have really means my sister cannot get probate before March 2025.

CONTENTIOUS PROBATE

I am from an Indian family, born in the capital Delhi on 28/08/1958.. I need to consult someone qualified about a probate matter. I want to find out if I can stop my sister from being granted probate. I have been given a caveat number in this connection, which is valid until March 2025. I want to explain the circumstances why I would like this to happen and find out if this caveat number REALLY means my sister will not get probate until March 2025.

I want to pay for a consultation, as I have no money to litigate with my sister to release the will. The National Will Register, which charged 140 pounds, was unsuccessful in locating the will. A lawyer on Justanswer, who does not accept clients, said the best way to recover the will from a sibling who won't release it is to threaten to litigate them.

If possible, I would also like to say she is unfit to be an executor as she took advantage of the injunction she set up against me in 2013, along with trumped-up conviction harassment without violence.

My sister stopped my father talking to me on WhatsApp the last few months of his life as he deteriorated in her home. She returned registered post I sent my father and had a large animal to bark at visitors when an Indian friend tried to ring the bell to do a live and well check on Dad and speak in our language.

If the will was changed in those last few months, I would also like to know.

In January/February 2024, my father was talking daily on WhatsApp, from the privacy of his own home, saying he was doddering old and waiting to join my mother.

He reassured me he would never disinherit me because Viju hated me.

If I were the executor, I would want the will to be public and everything distributed, honestly, unselfishly, according to my late beloved father's wishes.

I was told it is a contentious matter.

FAMILY BACKGROUND/STORY

My name is Mohini Hersom. I am 66 years old and live in Dublin, Ireland.

My father, Mr. KrishnaSwami Venkataramanan, died on the 1st of August 2024, aged 90 years, at Basingstoke hospHospital. UK.

Since 2006, my parents resided at 19 Carson Grove, at postcode RG317ZN. My mother Radha had already died in 2022, aged 88 years. My father is survived by two children. The other child is Vijju Wortley, aged 62 years, who lives in Mala Sandy Lane, Tadley, RG263PA, UK. Vijju is 6-12 miles from my late parents' home. My father loved his independence, but as he deteriorated, had no choice but to move in with Vijju and Steve.

I was living in the UK from 2004 to 2018. I am now a legal resident of Ireland. On the other hand, my sister has been living in the UK since 1981.

We sisters, born and raised in India since birth, migrated to England in 1981 with our parents. It was because my father's employer in India transferred him for two years to England.

I attended Manchester University, while Vijju attended Salford University. I graduated from you UMIST, Manchester, in 1983 and left the UK for the US.

In 1983, my parents went back to India because my father's job had been completed. My sister did not graduate until 1984. She stayed back to complete her studies. At that time, she got married to her classmate Stephen Wortley.

Since their graduation, Steven has been working at the atomic weapons establishment and is a senior scientist there. Vijju is an accountant, and they live at the above address in Tadley. They have a son and a daughter. They are now grown up and not staying with their parents.

After my departure in 1983, I returned to the UK in 2004. This was entirely the choice of my newlywed husband, Nicholas Hersom, who is an Englishman. Nick and I were divorced in 2009. In 2011, Nick returned to Canada, where I first met him.

I met another gentleman at the Institute of Physics because I am a physicist. We started living together. I want to keep this brief because it's not a probate matter. That is, I had some immigration difficulties in the UK. These difficulties commenced because of the breakdown of my relationship with Mr. Hersom. Had that not happened, there was no point in law that they could use to give me immigration difficulties.

The term immigration difficulties implies that they want to send you back to your country. These difficulties were unusual for someone like me, and the complete reasons are not known. I believe they are partially or totally because of my sister,

who has some contacts in the home of his, according to my late mother.

The only thing I can clearly establish is that I was given a trumped-up conviction called harassment without violence by Vijay Wortley in 2013. She got an injunction along with it. She told my father when he was alive that she would never drop the injunction. The other thing is that I left the UK voluntarily in 2018, because of good reason to fear that I would be sent back to India. I got legal residence in Ireland in 2022

My sister has many ways of communicating with me. She knows the address and phone number of my boyfriend in London, called Alex. She can also get in touch with me through the Hampshire County Council or Basingstoke police, who would also know how to contact me. My parents neighbors in their house where they used to live also have my contact

She did not talk to us not to inform us of my father's death. I had been emailing and phoning Hampshire County Council since May 2024 and got in touch with the local church, who helped but the County Council refused to help me.

Some people were very nasty leading me to fear I would face nothing but hatred.

I think I've told you my story.

MY FINANCIAL AND OTHER CIRCUMSTANCES

I have been on disability allowance in Ireland after a doctor recommended me for this due to heart failure.

On 28th August 2024, this Irish dole was stopped. They said they are not paying out any more because of my father's inheritance. Unfortunately, I do not have the will and do not have inheritance. But to pay a solicitor, I'm going to need them to pay me some money. I've got too much on my plate. I need to get money or find work and not a soul to help me.

I think I'm perceived as a piece of shit in Ireland, because unless I can work it with women's organisations, I can't have any work. I'm rather educated, and there's a big difference between me and the rest of the population.

I have no facility with women and women's organizations. I have no future ,but to face the full blast of people's hatred /prejudice, just because I have not partnered with women's organizations. I would like to get a tech job or something working from home. Obviously I can't do it in a cabin by myself or with just women involved.

I'll be appealing the dole refusal in Ireland, but life is nothing but misery and no future. The Irish dole people have asked me to beg and eat and soup kitchens. I have been thinking for many years that I should die of euthanasia because I can have nothing but women. I think it's a good idea to exit the planet if there is no way to exit the rut and "women's prison". Life as chronic invalid with no \$\$ to eat.

That's just my financial and life history, which I'd like anyone to take into account when that you yesterday enjoying me. I was falsely accused by my sister, and I'm sure some truth will leak out if they only investigate. I was never interested in Viju and her children, and I did not harass them. I feel confident I am physically and mentally fit to work part time from home. I am trying to write a book about my 14 years in England and my trumped-up criminal conviction Harassment without Violence.
