- A Grant of Letters of Administration to the Claimant or an independent administrator;
- An order giving effect to the Claimant's interest in the property of 19 Carston Grove, Calcot, reading, RG31 7ZN via Proprietary Estoppel;
- An order that the Defendant pays the costs of this claim;
- Such consequential directions as the court deems appropriate.
