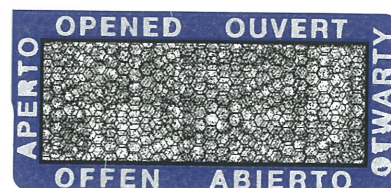
You will need to remember to follow these security tips

Card reference details

For security reasons, we do not include your full card number with this letter. To identify which card this PIN belongs to, use the four-digit card reference number overleaf. It will match the last four digits of the eight-digit number on the bottom of your card. For example, if the last four digits of your card number were 1234, the number shown overleaf would be 123X.

Changing your PIN

If you'd like to change the PIN on this letter you can do so at a Bank of Ireland ATM. Select **PIN/Other Services** and then choose the **PIN Change** option.

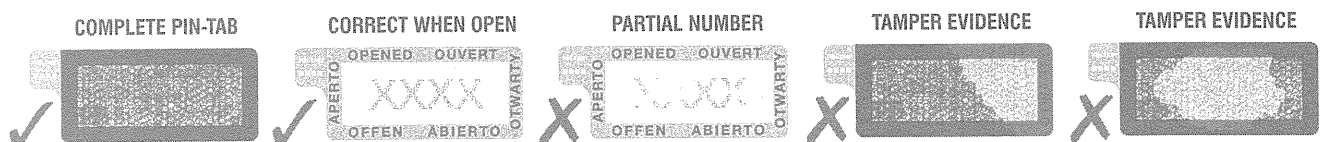
Make it personal

A PIN that's personal to you is generally easier to remember. We advise you NOT to choose one that can be easily discovered, like your date of birth or numbers in descending or ascending order (for example 9876, 4567), or four of the same numbers (for example 1111, 9999).

Keep your PIN secret at all times.

Never write down and keep your PIN in your wallet/purse or on the card itself. If you think someone has discovered your PIN, contact Customer Services on 0618 365 365 immediately.

If you believe this letter has already been opened or your Pin-Tab looks similar to the images below with evidence of tampering, please call your issuer. Otherwise, gently peel back the Pin-Tab.



To read your PIN more clearly, place the film on white paper. You must destroy the film once you have memorised your PIN.
