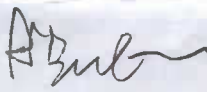
Dear Ms Hersom

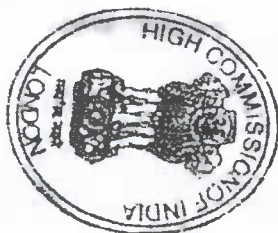

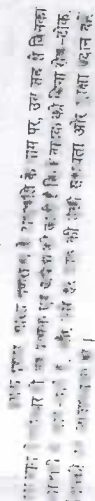
